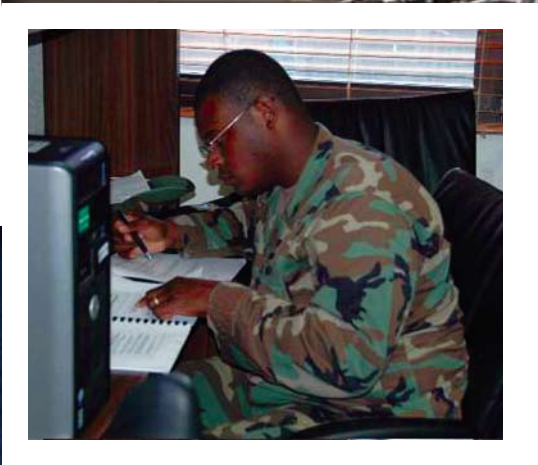


# CHS Trains Navy at Guam
